
4th FEBRUARY 2020 meeting of Feltham History Group

Tony Fredjohn provided an update of Feltham Magistrates Court and the ongoing Tesco's land problem in the High Street



The Secretary spoke on matters of railway lines , i.e. the line that used to run across the High St into Feltham Depot "during works in High St a rail was exposed, members may remember that a line was put into the depot to properly service the facility, additionally following removal of a row Leylandii near Elmwood Rd entrance to the depot part of the railway line was exposed – coincidently the Secretary was sent a box of items on local history by a son of a onetime member of H&DHS which contained an image of the line in the depot 'below Depot line images shows same position but 37 years apart'
